

## GREEN

Normal driving for all vehicles. Normal operations and all base services open.

## AMBER

Mild to severe conditions. Exercise caution. No more than 4 inches of snow. Possibility of slush, packed snow, black ice or low visibility. Most installation operations and services open, but late reporting or early release of DODDS students and base personnel could be authorized. See **Update Info** for latest road conditions.

## RED

Very hazardous roads. Exercise extreme caution. Possible snow of more than 4 inches, sheets of ice, drifting snow, low visibility. Do not plan on running errands. **Limit your driving to only essential trips to and from work. Expect late reporting or early release of base services and probably closure of all but mission essential activities.**

## BLACK

Extremely dangerous roads. May be more than 8 inches of snow, sheets of ice, very low visibility. Privately-owned vehicles should not be out. **Installations will be closed and vehicle movement on base stopped.**

• Color coded road condition summaries provide information on general conditions of primary roads in the immediate area of KMC installations. Roads including:

- B-40
- B-270
- Autobahns

• These road condition summaries **do not** apply to the many smaller roads throughout the KMC.

• Road conditions in higher elevation areas, such as south of Landstuhl and Sembach area, may be more hazardous than the road condition summaries indicate.

- Exercise caution when traveling
- Use your best judgement

• **Late-reporting** or **installation closure** decisions are normally made no later than **4:30 a.m.** to allow adequate time to complete notifications. For the same reason, any decisions made to **release early** are normally made by **10:30 a.m.**

• However, commanders may consider early release whenever weather conditions significantly deteriorate.

• During **Road Condition Amber**, be tuned to these information venues, as road conditions may decline quickly. **Delays possible.**

• During **Road Condition Red**, work, schools, and buses will be **delayed**. Contact your Unit POC/SLO for more reporting information.

• During **Road Condition Black**, schools, buses, and the base will be **CLOSED**. All vehicle movement will be stopped. **Contact your Unit POC for further instructions or mission essential reporting instructions.**

• **480-COLD** and **480-TALK** are phone lines available to ensure 24-hour up-to-date information on road conditions.

• During severe weather (**Road Conditions Red** and **Black**) AFN television will post a crawl message informing viewers of the change.

• KMC members can also listen to AFN live programming on Z-100.2 FM from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Disc jockeys update changes regularly on air.
